An Act to amend the Education Act

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 30 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, is replaced by the following : 62 V., c. 28, art. 30, replaced.

“**30.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council, may, at any time, and whenever he deems it necessary, annul the administrative acts and appointments made by him and make new administrative acts and appointments in place of those he has annulled.” Lieutenant-Governor in Council may annul acts and appointments, &c.
2. Article 150 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following : Id., 150, amended.

“But for the school municipality of the parish of St. Pierre de la Pointe aux Esquimaux, in the county of Saguenay, such meeting shall be held on the first juridical Monday of the month of March.” Exception for certain school municipality.
3. Article 155 of the said act is amended by adding after the words: “July” in the third line, the words: “or in March for the school municipality of the parish of St. Pierre de la Pointe aux Esquimaux, in the county of Saguenay.” Id., 155, amended.
4. Article 234 of the said act is amended by adding after the word: “Lieutenant-Governor” in the second line, the words: “in Council.” Id., 234, amended.
5. Article 274 of the said act is replaced by the following : Id., 274, replaced.

“**274.** The secretary-treasurer is bound to make, between the first day of September and the first day of October of every year, a census of the children of the school municipality, and the school commissioners and trustees shall see that he performs such duty. In such census the secretary treasurer must distinguish those children that are from seven to fourteen years of age, those from five to seven, and those from fourteen to sixteen, showing the number of each of these categories actually attending school.” Annual census of children.
6. Article 378 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the words: “saving those which are exempt from seizure.” Id., 378, amended.
7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
