An Act to amend the law respecting jurors

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

§ 2, amended. **1.** Paragraph 2 of article 2618 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by the act 58 Victoria, chapter 31, section 5, is further amended by striking out the words " or in the district of Pontiac," in the second line.

after id. **2.** The following paragraph is inserted in the Revised Statutes, after the said paragraph 2 of article 2618 :

Grand jurors
in district of
Pontiac. " 2a. Every male person, in the district of Pontiac, domiciled within the limits of any municipality, any part whereof is situated within forty miles of the place of holding the court in the said district, and entered upon the valuation roll as proprietor of immoveable property of a value of above one thousand dollars, or as occupant or tenant for an annual value of above one hundred dollars."

§ 2, amended. **3.** Paragraph 2 of article 2619 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 25, section 1, is further amended by striking out the words : " or in the district of Pontiac," in the second line.

after id. **4.** The following paragraph is inserted in the Revised Statutes, after the said paragraph 2 of article 2619 :

Petit jurors
in district of
Pontiac. " 2a. Every male person in the district of Pontiac, domiciled within the limits of any municipality, any part whereof is situated within forty miles of the place of holding the court in the said district, and entered upon the valuation roll as proprietor of a total value of at least four hundred dollars and not more than one thousand dollars, or as occupant or tenant for an annual value of at least forty dollars and not more than one hundred dollars."

Coming into
force. **5.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
