An Act respecting the floating of pulp wood

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., 4921,
amended.

1. Article 4921 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding, after the word "timber" in the fifth line, the words "or pulp wood."

C H A P. 35

An Act to amend the law respecting Mutual Fire Insurance Companies

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., 5290,
replaced.

1. Article 5290 of the Revised Statutes is replaced by the following :

each risk
limited.

"**5290.** The board of directors shall in no case issue a policy for an amount exceeding five thousand dollars on one risk; provided also that the amount of insurance effected in cities and towns does not exceed twenty-five per cent. of the total insurances effected by the company."

2. Article 5319 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding thereto the following clause :

Notice of
assessments
need not be
published.

"It shall be lawful for the company to dispense with publishing the rate of assessments in a newspaper, provided a notice of such assessments is sent to each member of the company by mail."

Id., 5325,
amended.

3. Article 5325 of the Revised Statutes is amended by striking out the words "of the locality in which such fire happened," in the first and second lines of the third clause thereof.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
