An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit J.-Alexandre Legault amongst its members, after examination

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

WHEREAS J.-Alexandre Legault, student-at-law, residing in the town of Salaberry de Valleyfield, district of Beauharnois, has, by his petition, represented :

That he has followed a complete course of study in classics and sciences, but, through special circumstances beyond his control, was unable to undergo the necessary examination for admission to the study of law ;

That, since the month of April, 1895, he has devoted himself almost exclusively to the study of his profession, having attended as student-at-law the offices of the following advocates, to wit : Messrs. Seers & Laurendeau, Jasmin & Goyette, J. C. Lariviere and D. McAvoy ;

That he has therefore been a student for over four years and has thus acquired considerable legal knowledge ;

That he has prayed for the passing of an act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit him amongst its members after examination, and whereas it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said J.-Alexandre Legault amongst its members, after examination.
