

That various certificates from notaries who have employed him, and from other notaries, advocates and registrars, attest his qualifications as well as his respectability, and state that he is worthy of being admitted to the practice of the notarial profession in the Province of Quebec, without previous examination ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Admission of

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Joseph-Antoine Germano to the final examination for admission to practise the profession of notary, subject to the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of article 3822 of the Revised Statutes, and upon his proving that he has conducted himself properly since his residence in the country.

CHAP. 121

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to admit Léon-Domitien-Eugène Rousseau to the practise of the notarial profession

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Léon-Domitien-Eugène Rousseau, of the city of Quebec, advocate and notarial student has, by petition, represented :

That he has obtained the degree of Bachelor of Law at Laval University, that he was admitted to the Bar of this Province in July, 1894, and that since then he has practised the profession of advocate ;

That he has followed a complete course of classical studies, that he has not to undergo the examination for admission to the notarial profession, as he is a Bachelor of Letters of Laval University, and since the 30th August has served as a student with a practising notary ;

That, if he was obliged to continue his studentship in such quality of notarial student during three entire years, it would mean a useless loss of time on account of the knowledge and experience acquired by him during his study and practice of the legal profession ;

That he has been unable to obtain the approval of the Board of Notaries for the passing of an act to admit him to the practice of the notarial profession, as the said Board meets only once a year, to wit, in the month of July, and he only decided to study the said profession after the month of July last ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to reduce the period of studentship of Léon-Domitien-Eugène Rousseau to ten months from the thirtieth of August, 1901, to admit him as a notary and to allow him to practise such profession, as soon as he shall have passed the examination required for admission to the practice of the notarial profession.

CHAP. 122

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries to admit Louis Savard to the practice of the notarial profession, after the required examinations

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

WHEREAS Louis Savard, of the city of Quebec, law student, hath, by petition, represented :

That he has followed a course of classical studies in the Quebec Seminary ;

That he followed the law course at Laval University, Quebec, from the 4th October, 1898, and that he completed his university studies in June, 1901 ;

That, from the same time, he studied as clerk in the office of Mtre. J. A. Charlebois, and that he completed his three years' clerkship in October, 1901 ;

That he was duly admitted to the study of the notarial profession in the month of July, 1900 ;

That, for the reasons above-mentioned, it would be impossible for him to present himself before the Board of Notaries of this Province, before the month of July, 1903 ;

That, by a resolution of the 13th July, 1901, the Board of Notaries has agreed to the passing of this act ;
