

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Admission of
W. C. Mills
as physician.

1. William Charles Mills, heretofore of the city and district of Montreal, and presently of Chateauguay, in the State of New York, physician and surgeon, is authorized to practise his profession as physician and surgeon in this province, upon having obtained from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, after the examinations required for admission to practice, the license for practising medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this province.

CHAP. 125

An Act authorizing Gilbert Martin Bowen to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Gilbert Martin Bowen, of Hatley, in the county of Stanstead and Province of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented :

That he has taken a three years' course in dental surgery at the University of Maryland, at Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, one of the United States of America ;

That he followed the necessary and special course of study at the said University of Maryland where he obtained his diploma ;

That he entered the said University in the month of October, 1898 ;

That he followed the course of lectures, passed the examinations and received the degree of doctor of dental surgery on the thirtieth day of April, 1901, at the said college ;

That, between the sessions of the said college during the three years of his course, he attended the offices of dental surgeons as a student and practised dentistry in all its branches, but omitted to have indentures passed with his patrons ;

That, since receiving his diploma in 1901, he has practised the profession of surgeon-dentist in the State of Connecticut, one of the United States of America ;

That he possesses, through his studies and experience, all the required knowledge and qualifications ;

That he is now desirous of returning to live and practise his profession in the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act authorizing him to form part of the said association, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to grant the said Gilbert Martin Bowen a license of surgeon-dentist of this province with all the privileges connected therewith, after passing the examination required for admission to practise the said profession.

CHAP. 126

An Act to authorize Herbert Alexander McCrea to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

WHEREAS Herbert Alexander McCrea, of Hemmingford, in the county of Huntingdon, Province of Quebec, heretofore of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, has, by his petition, represented :

Preamble

That he has taken a three years' course in dental surgery at the Pennsylvania College of Dental Surgery, in Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, one of the United States of America ;

That he followed the necessary and special course of study at the said Pennsylvania College of Dental Surgery, where he obtained his diplomas ;

That during three years he has, between the sessions at the said college, attended the office of dental surgeons as a student, but omitted to have indentures passed with his patrons ;

That he entered the said college in the month of October, 1897 ;

That he followed the course of lectures, passed examinations and received the degree of doctor of dental surgery, on the second day of May, 1900, at the said college ;

That he possesses through his studies and experience all the required knowledge and qualifications ;
