

That he is now desirous of returning to live and practise his profession in the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act authorizing him to form part of the said association, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to grant the said Gilbert Martin Bowen a license of surgeon-dentist of this province with all the privileges connected therewith, after passing the examination required for admission to practise the said profession.

CHAP. 126

An Act to authorize Herbert Alexander McCrea to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

WHEREAS Herbert Alexander McCrea, of Hemmingford, in the county of Huntingdon, Province of Quebec, heretofore of Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, has, by his petition, represented :

Preamble

That he has taken a three years' course in dental surgery at the Pennsylvania College of Dental Surgery, in Philadelphia, in the State of Pennsylvania, one of the United States of America ;

That he followed the necessary and special course of study at the said Pennsylvania College of Dental Surgery, where he obtained his diplomas ;

That during three years he has, between the sessions at the said college, attended the office of dental surgeons as a student, but omitted to have indentures passed with his patrons ;

That he entered the said college in the month of October, 1897 ;

That he followed the course of lectures, passed examinations and received the degree of doctor of dental surgery, on the second day of May, 1900, at the said college ;

That he possesses through his studies and experience all the required knowledge and qualifications ;

That he is now desirous of returning to live and practise his profession in the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act authorizing him to form part of the dental association of the Province of Quebec, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is authorized to grant the said Herbert Alexander McCrea a license of surgeon-dentist in this Province, with all the privileges connected with it, after examination for admission to practise in the said province.

CHAP. 127

An Act to authorize Joachim Reid to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 26th March, 1902]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Joachim Reid, dentist, of the parish of St. Ambroise de la Jeune Lorette, has, by his petition, represented :

That he followed a course of classical studies, up to the class of rhetoric inclusively, at Montreal College from 1882 to 1888 ;

That, in the year 1889, he became a student with a licensed dentist at Chippewa Falls, Wisconsin, in the United States of America, to study the theory and practice of the art of dentistry, and made all the necessary and special studies at the North Western College of Dental Surgery, University of Chicago, duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Illinois, where he obtained the diploma of doctor of dental surgery on the 10th April 1892 ;

That he practised his profession in the United States until his return to Canada ;

That, since the month of July, 1900, he has regularly attended a dentist's surgery in Quebec as assistant to Dr. Larocque, dentist ;

That, through his studies and experience, he possesses all the necessary knowledge and qualifications ;

That he is desirous of returning to his native country and of living in the Province of Quebec ;
