

CHAP. 23

An Act to amend the law respecting cemeteries and interments and disinterments

[Assented to 26th March, 1901]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

- R. S., 3459, amended. **1.** Article 3459 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 28, section 2, is amended by replacing the words "as provided by article 3059e," in the fourth line, by the following : "or a transport permit exchanged for such certificate, as prescribed by article 109 of the act 1 Edward VII, chapter 19, amending and consolidating the law respecting public health."
- R. S., 3372b, amended. **2.** Article 3372b of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 28, section 1, is amended by inserting after the word "mission," in the seventh line of paragraph 2, the words "or of the Board of Health."
- R. S., 3465, amended. **3.** Article 3465 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the said act, is amended by striking out the words "of typhoid fever," in the fifth line.
- Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 24

An Act respecting the admission of certain students to the Bar

[Assented to 26th March, 1901]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

- Certain students may present themselves for examination. **1.** Notwithstanding article 3552 of the Revised Statutes, any student who has been regularly admitted to the study of law previously to the Bar examinations of the month of July, 1900, whose clerkship is otherwise regular, but whose certificate of admission to study has not been registered, shall have the right to present himself for any examination for which he might have presented himself if his certificate had been registered at the time of his admission to study ;
