

provided he has such certificate registered within three months from the coming into force of this act and complies with the regulations of the Bar respecting the registration of certificates of admission to study. Proviso

The same privilege is extended to every student regularly admitted as aforesaid whose certificate of admission to study has not been registered with sufficient diligence. Privilege extended to certain other students.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

## CHAP. 25

An Act respecting the act 63 Victoria, chapter 28

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

**W**HEREAS Bill No. 106 of the Legislative Assembly passed by that House, was rejected by the Legislative Council on the 23rd March, 1900, but a copy thereof, certified as having been sanctioned by the Lieutenant-Governor, was delivered to the Printer of Her late Majesty the Queen and printed by him among the Statutes of last session as chapter 28; Preamble

Whereas it is now necessary to remedy that error;

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The act 63 Victoria, chapter 28, intituled: "An act to amend article 3998 of the Revised Statutes," never having been passed or sanctioned by His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, is null and of no effect, and the amendment thereby effected to the said article shall be considered as having never existed. 63 V., c. null.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
