An Act respecting the continuation of community

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

WHEREAS it may appear doubtful under the provisions Preamble. of the act 60 Victoria, chapter 52, whether a community which was dissolved before the passing of the said act should be governed by the rules respecting continuation of community ;

Whereas it is expedient to remove all such doubts :

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The provisions of the act 60 Victoria, chapter 52, do not affect communities which were dissolved before the coming into force of the said act, which are and continue to be governed by the rules respecting continuation of community as if the said statute had not been passed. 60 V., c. 52; not to affect communities dissolved before it came into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

C H A P. 33

An Act to amend article 94 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 94 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the act 63 Victoria, chapter 41, section 1, is further amended by adding the following words at the end of paragraph 3 : “ or if it concerns a suit for libel published in a newspaper, before the court of any district in which such paper is circulated, and in which the plaintiff resides.” C. C. P., 94, amended.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
