

## C H A P. 34

An Act to amend article 165 of the Code of Civil  
Procedure

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 165,  
amended.

**1.** Article 165 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended  
by adding the two following clauses thereto :

Deposit  
required for  
certain mo-  
tions only.  
Not required  
for certain  
motions.

“ The deposit is not required except upon motions made  
under articles 170, 173, 174, 177, 183 and 190, which are  
considered as preliminary pleas to the action.

The deposit is not required upon motions for particulars,  
for production of documents, to reject some of the allegations  
of the declaration, and other like motions. ”

Coming into  
force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-  
tion.

## C H A P. 35

## An Act to amend article 237 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 237,  
amended.

**1.** Article 237 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended  
by adding thereto the following paragraph :

If judge is re-  
lated, &c., to  
attorney, &c.,  
of one of the  
parties.

“ 8. If he is related or allied to the attorney or counsel, or  
to the partner of the attorney or counsel of one of the parties  
to the suit, either in the direct line or to the second degree  
in the collateral line.”
