

CHAP. 106

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Walter G. Mitchell amongst its members

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Walter G. Mitchell, of the city of Montreal, in the district of Montreal, has studied law for three full years and has passed the required preliminary examination, and will this year graduate in law from McGill University; appear;

And whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act permitting him to appear before the Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec, next July or at any time subsequent thereto, for examination to be admitted to practise as an advocate of the Province of Quebec, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of the Province, enacts as follows:

Admission of
W. G. Mitchell
to Bar.

1. Walter G. Mitchell is authorized to present himself before the Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec in July, 1901, or at any time subsequent thereto for final examination to be admitted to practise as an advocate of the Province of Quebec; and the Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to examine the said Walter G. Mitchell at the said final examination in the month of July, 1901, or at such time subsequent thereto as he shall present himself for the said final examination, and, so soon as he shall have passed the said final examination, the Council of the Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit him as an advocate of the Province of Quebec.

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
