

1. Cyrille F. Lussier, physician and surgeon, heretofore of the parish of St. Damase in the district of St. Hyacinthe, now of New Bedford in the United States of America, is declared to form part of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, which is authorized to grant him the license required to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this Province, from the date of the sanction of this act, after the examination required for admission to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics.

## CHAP. 109

An Act to authorize James Peter Pidgeon to practise the profession of physician and surgeon in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 28th March, 1901]

WHEREAS James Peter Pidgeon, of Lewiston, Maine, in the United States, has, by his petition, represented :

Preamble.

That ten years ago, to wit, in eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, he obtained his degrees in medicine at Laval and Victoria in this Province ;

That he has since practised his said profession of physician and surgeon for ten years in New Brunswick and Lewiston, Maine, successively ;

That, through his studies and experience, he possesses all the necessary knowledge and qualifications ;

That he now desires to return to the Province of Quebec and reside therein ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act authorizing him to practise medicine and surgery in this Province, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The said James Peter Pidgeon is authorized, after examination, to obtain from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec the necessary license for practising medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this Province.
