CHAP. 5

An Act respecting a loan to the Vaccine Establishment

[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]

WHEREAS in virtue of an Order in Council of the 29th December, 1887, the Provincial Treasurer was, for the purpose of assisting Dr. Louis Edmond Gauvreau in carrying on his vaccine establishment for the production of pure vaccine, in the interest of public health, authorized to advance to him the sum of \$2,500, upon condition that the said advance would be repayable with interest at the end of five years, provided the said Doctor Gauvreau did not carry on his vaccine establishment and supply pure vaccine during that term, and was further authorized to accept a mortgage upon the said establishment for the repayment of the said advance if the stipulated conditions were not fulfilled ;

Whereas the said sum of \$2,500 was afterwards paid over to the said Doctor Gauvreau, under the act 51-52 Victoria, chapter 1, schedule B, item 243 ;

Whereas a deed of mortgage embodying the said conditions was granted by Doctor Gauvreau, on the 14th January, 1888, and accepted by the Provincial Treasurer, mortgaging the said vaccine establishment as security for the said advance ;

Whereas Doctor Gauvreau having faithfully and to the satisfaction of the Government carried out all the requirements of the said Order in Council, during the term of five years therein stipulated, is entitled to have the said mortgage cancelled, and has prayed that *main-levée* thereof be granted ;
