### CHAP. 11

An Act to amend the Quebec Election Act, 1895, respecting the examination and putting into force of the list of electors

*[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]*

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 32 of the act 59 Victoria, chapter 9, is amended <sup>59 V., c. 9,</sup> by replacing the words : “ the publication of the notice, <sup>art. 32,</sup> given in virtue of article 26 ”, in the fifth and sixth <sup>amended.</sup> lines, by the words : “ the expiration of the delay prescribed for the preparation of the list or, if the list has been completed after the expiration of the said delay, within the thirty days after the notice given in virtue of article 26.”

**2.** Article 33 of the said act is amended by replacing the <sup>Id. 33,</sup> words : “ the publication of the notice given under article <sup>amended.</sup> 26,” in the fifth and sixth lines, by the words : “ the expiration of the delay prescribed for the preparation of the list or, if the list has been completed after the expiration of the said delay, within the fifteen days after the notice given in virtue of article 26.”

**3.** Article 40 of the said act is amended by replacing the <sup>11. 40</sup> words : “ notice given in virtue of article 26,” in the second <sup>amended.</sup>

and third lines, by the words : “ expiration of the delay prescribed for the preparation of the list or, if the list has been completed after the expiration of the said delay, within the thirty days after the notice given in virtue of article 26.”

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction, and shall apply to the lists which have been prepared or are to be prepared in the year 1900.
