An Act respecting jury trials in civil matters in the county of Gaspé

[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following paragraph and article are added to the Revised Statutes after article 2379 : Par. and art. added after R. S. 2379.

§ 4a.—*Jury Trials in the county of Gaspé*

“**2379a.** So long as there are not at least seventy-five names of persons, qualified to serve as jurors in civil cases, on the list prepared by the prothonotary of the Superior Court for the county of Gaspé, no jury trial can be had therein in civil cases.” No jury trials in civil cases in county of Gaspé until certain event.

2. All motions and options in any proceeding praying for a jury trial in civil matters in any case now pending before the court in the county of Gaspé are declared null, and the proceedings in any such case shall be continued since the last proceeding as if such motion or option had not been made. Certain proceedings in pending cases declared null.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
