## CHAP. 22

An Act to amend the law respecting public buildings

[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]

**H**ER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 2973 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by R. S., 2973, the act 57 Victoria, chapter 29, section 1, is amended, by <sup>amended.</sup> adding, at the end thereof, the words : “ shops and stores of all sizes, and buildings of three stories or more over the ground floor occupied as offices.”

**2.** Article 2979 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by R. S., 2979, the said act, is replaced by the following : <sup>replaced.</sup>

“**2979.** The said inspectors have, *mutatis mutandis*, the <sup>Powers of in-</sup> same powers and are subject to the same obligations, as re- <sup>spectors, &c.</sup> gards safety, health and morality in public buildings, as that indicated in the fourth section and in the regulations made by the Lieutenant-Governor in council respecting the safety, health and morality of employees in industrial establishments, in so far as the same may be applicable thereto.”

**3.** Article 2987 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by R. S., 2987, the said act, is amended as follows : <sup>amended.</sup>

By adding, after clause *b* of paragraph 1, the following :  
“(c) The safety, health and morality of the keepers, work- <sup>Regulations</sup> men, workwomen, clerks or other persons employed in <sup>respecting</sup> public buildings.” <sup>health, &c.</sup>

By adding to paragraph 2 the following words :  
 Rules, &c., of Board of Health not to be affected. “Nor shall anything in this law affect the rules and regulations adopted by the Board of Health of the Province of Quebec on the same subject.”

Coming into force. **4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
