### CHAP. 88

An Act to amend the charter of *La Compagnie du Conservatoire de Montréal*.

[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]

**WHEREAS** *La Compagnie du Conservatoire de Montréal* Preamble.  
has, by its petition represented that it would be an advantage to it to change its corporate name if necessary, and to modify its powers ;

Whereas it is expedient to grant the petitioner's prayer ;  
Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The following section is added after section 6 of the act 61 Victoria, chapter 84 :

**“ 6a.** It shall be lawful for the said company, by by-law adopted by the majority of three-fourths of its members, to change its corporate name to that of the National Company of Montreal, to reduce its capital to two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and to specify the nature of its bonds, and the rate of interest thereon, provided such by-law shall have no effect until notice thereof is given in the *Quebec Official Gazette*.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
