An Act to amend the act 27-28 Victoria, chapter 163, incorporating the Trustees of the American Presbyterian Society of Montreal

[Assented to 23rd March, 1900]

WHEREAS the Trustees of the American Presbyterian Society of Montreal, by petition, have prayed for amendments to their charter ; and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioners ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Section 13 of the act 27-28 Victoria, chapter 163, is replaced by the following :

“ 13. All holders of one or more sittings in the said church or place of worship, whether holding the same by purchase or lease from the said trustees before the coming into force of this act, or from the said corporation after the coming into force of this act, and such seat-holders only shall be considered members of the said congregation, for the purposes in this act mentioned and declared, and shall have a right to vote upon all matters submitted at the meetings of the congregation, called as hereinafter directed ; provided that no such seat-holder shall be entitled to vote at any meeting of the congregation, unless he shall have been the actual occupant

of a seat for at least one year immediately previous to such meeting, and unless all the seat-rent due and payable by him shall have been paid in full up to the date of such meeting."
