

## CAP. L

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting the privileges  
of *voyageurs*, lumberers, and others.

[Assented to 10th March, 1899.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The last clause of paragraph 1 of article 1994<sup>c</sup> of the C. C., 1994<sup>c</sup>, Civil Code, as enacted by the act 57 Victoria, chapter 47, amended, section 1, is amended by replacing the words "verbal notice" in the nineteenth and twentieth lines by the words "written notice" and by repealing the words "in the presence of two witnesses or a notice in writing" in the twenty-first and twenty-second lines.

## CAP. LI

An Act to amend article 2250 of the Civil Code.

[Assented to 10th March, 1899.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2250 of the Civil Code is amended by insert- C. C., 2250,  
ing, after the words "the Crown," in the first line, the amended,  
words "and interest on judgments,."

## CAP. LII

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure.

[Assented to 10th March, 1899.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 15 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended C. C. P., 15,  
by adding, after the figures "750" in paragraph 8, the amended,  
words and figures "761, 762, and 763".

2. Article 33 of the said Code is amended by replacing Id., 33,  
the word "and," in the fifth line, by the word "or". amended.
