

## CAP. XVII.

An Act to annex certain lots of the parishes of St. George and St. Francis, in the county of Beauce, to St. Benjamin, in the county of Dorchester.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS the canonical mission of St. Benjamin, in the county of Dorchester, comprises also several lots in the parishes of St. George and St. Francis, in the county of Beauce, and it is expedient to annex them to the said county of Dorchester;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Certain lots of St. George and St. Francis, county of Beauce, annexed to St. Benjamin, county of Dorchester.

**1.** Ranges 5 and 6 and the St. Jean concession of the parish of St. George, in the county of Beauce, and ranges 5 and 6 of the parish of St. Francis, in the said county, are detached therefrom and annexed to the county of Dorchester for all purposes ; and, together with lots A. and 1 to 11, inclusively, in the first range ; A. D. and 1 to 11 in the 2nd range ; and A. B. C. D. and 1 to 31 in the 3rd range ; and ranges D. E. and F. of the township of Watford ; lots A. and 1 to 29, inclusively, in the 11th and 12th ranges, and lots A. B. and 1 to 29 in the 13th and 14th ranges of the township of Cranbourne, shall form the municipality of St. Benjamin, which municipality shall be a local municipality, in the county of Dorchester, for all purposes.

Coming into force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## CAP. XVIII.

An Act concerning certain lots in the official cadastre of the parish of St. Féréol.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS, at the time of the preparation of the cadastre of certain parishes in the county of Montmorency, the lots now known as Nos. 609 to 648, inclusively, of the official plan and book of reference thereto of the parish of Saint Féréol, were, by error, omitted from the plan and book of reference for the parish of Sainte Anne ;

Whereas, owing to such omission, doubts have arisen respecting the parish to which these lots belong, and it is necessary to remove such doubts ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The lots now known as numbers 609 to 648, inclusively, of the official plan and book of reference thereto of the parish of Saint Féréol, in the county of Montmorency, are declared to belong and to have always belonged, for all purposes, to the parish of Sainte Anne, in the said county. Certain lots declared to belong to parish of Ste. Anne.

2. This act shall not affect pending cases, and shall not be interpreted as conferring upon the parish of Sainte Anne the right of imposing taxes upon such lots for the past. Effect of act.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

## C A P. X I X.

An Act respecting the annexation of a portion of the school municipality of Hochelaga to the city of Montreal, for school purposes.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

**W**HEREAS the Board of Roman Catholic School Commissioners of the city of Montreal has, by petition, prayed that the order in council passed on the fifteenth December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, by the Honorable Executive Council of this Province, and approved by His Honor the Lieutenant-Governor, on the seventeenth December, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, by which the territory hereinafter described has been annexed to the city of Montreal, for school purposes, to wit: "the territory bounded by Sherbrooke street, south side, the centre of Iberville street, the centre of Harbor street, from Sherbrooke street to Notre Dame street, the north-east line of lot 164 of the cadastre of the former village of Hochelaga, but not including lots Nos. 35, 36, 37 and 38 of the cadastre of the former village of Hochelaga, and lots Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17, subdivisions of lot 162 of the former village of Hochelaga, less all the portions of land belonging to the Canadian Pacific Railway Company," shall be considered as having been passed before the first of July last; such annexation to affect Roman Catholics only; and whereas it is expedient to grant their prayer; Preamble.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The said order in council shall have full effect as if it had been adopted and approved previous to the first of July, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six. Certain order in council approved.
