

CAP. XXV.

An Act to amend the Quebec Game Laws.

[Assented to 9th January 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., 1399, §§
2 and 3, re-
placed.

1. Paragraphs 2 and 3 of article 1399 of the Revised Statutes, as replaced by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 20, section 1, are again replaced by the following :

Mink, &c.

"2. Any mink, otter, marten, pekan, fox or lynx, between the first day of April and the first day of November in any year.

Hare,
Bear.

"3. Any hare, between the first day of February and the first day of November in any year, or any bear between the first day of July and the twentieth day of August in any year."

2. Paragraph 1 of article 1400 of the said Revised Statutes, as amended by the acts 53 Victoria, chapter 20, section 1, and 58 Victoria, chapter 21, sections 1 and 2, is further amended as follows :

1. By adding after the word : "snipe," in the first line of paragraph *a*, the words : "plover, curlew, tattler, or sand-piper" ;

2. By replacing the word : "May," in the third line of paragraph *b*, by the word : "March" ;

3. By replacing paragraph *c* by the following :

"*c.* At any time of the year between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise, in any manner whatever, any woodcock, snipe or partridge."

3. Article 1412 of the said Revised Statutes is amended by replacing the word : "three," in the first line, by the word : "six."

4. Article 1413 of the said Revised Statutes is replaced by the following :

"**1413.** There shall be, for the purpose of specially insuring the execution of this section and of all other laws respecting hunting, which may be passed for this Province, a game superintendent general, at a salary not exceeding \$1800, and a game inspector general at a salary not exceeding \$1500, appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

The said two officers shall, at the same time, perform the duties of superintendent and inspector of fisheries for the whole Province."

5. Article 1416 of the said Revised Statutes, as replaced R. S., 1416, by the act 59 Victoria, chapter 20, section 8, is again re-^{replaced.} placed by the following :

"1416. Every such permit shall be issued by the Com-^{Issue of per-} missioner, or by any other person designated by him, upon mits upon pay-^{ment of fees.} payment of fees according to the tariff established by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

The fee may be reduced if the permit is issued to a mem-^{Reduction of} ber of any fish and game club, which is incorporated under fee in certain^{cases.} the laws of the Province and has complied with the provisions of such laws; but on condition that such club is lessee of a hunting reserve in accordance with article 1417a.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-^{Coming into} tion.^{force.}

C A P. XXVI.

An Act respecting Trembling Mountain Park.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to set apart as a forest reserve, to form part of the Trembling Mountain Park, the following territory :<sup>Certain terri-
tory set apart
for addition
to park.</sup>

1. The undivided portion of the township of Joly, in the county of Ottawa ;

2. The undivided portion of the township of Marchand, in the same county ;

3. The whole of that portion of the counties of Montcalm and Joliette, comprised between the north-western limits of the townships of Archambault and Lussier and the prolongation thereof to the north-east, as far as the county of Berthier, and the exploration grand line from the river du Lièvre to the river St. Maurice, less the township of Lynch and the portions of the townships of Mousseau and Nantel, now divided.

2. The provisions of sections 3, 4 and 7 to 22, inclu-<sup>58 V., c. 22,

to park.</sup> sively, of the act 58 Victoria, chapter 22, apply to Trembling Mountain Park.
