

CAP. XXX.

An Act to amend the law respecting the sittings of the Superior Court.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., 2332,
amended.

1. Article 2332 of the Revised Statutes is amended by striking out the words: "St. Francis," in the first line of the second clause of paragraph 2 thereof.

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CAP. XXXI.

An Act to amend the law respecting the Circuit Court of the District of Montreal.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

56 V., c. 24, s.
2, replaced.

1. Section 2 of the act 56 Victoria, chapter 24, is replaced by the following:

Composition
of court.

"2. Such court shall be composed of three judges called: 'Circuit Judges of the District of Montreal,' who shall be advocates of ten years' practice, to be chosen from among the members of the Bar of the Province, and be appointed by the competent authorities."

amended.

2. Section 5 of the said act is amended by adding thereto the following:

When all
judges to sit,
&c.

"2. Whenever the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may so require, the three judges shall sit at the same time, in different rooms, during the hours which he may designate, and exercise all the powers of the court."

Coming into
force.

3. This act shall come into force upon the day which the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may be pleased to fix by proclamation.
