

CAP. XXXV.

An Act to amend the law respecting Commissioners' Courts.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2415 of the Revised Statutes is amended by R. S., 2415, replacing paragraph 2 by the following : amended.

CAP. XXXVI.

An Act to amend the law respecting constables' fees.

1. Article 2593 of the Revised Statutes is amended by R. S., 2593, replacing the word : "felony," in the first line thereof, by amended. the words : "offences enumerated in article 540 of the Criminal Code, 1892."
