

CAP. XXXV.

An Act to amend the law respecting Commissioners' Courts.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2415 of the Revised Statutes is amended by replacing paragraph 2 by the following : R. S., 2415, amended.

“ 2. Upon proof to his satisfaction that any commissioners' court has not sat for upwards of two years, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may abolish such court, and a notice of such abolition shall be published for one month in the *Quebec Official Gazette*. Lieutenant-Governor may abolish court.

“ 3. No court so suspended, discontinued or abolished shall be re-established, unless on a petition signed and certified as required by article 2408.” In what cases any court may be re-established.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CAP. XXXVI.

An Act to amend the law respecting constables' fees.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2593 of the Revised Statutes is amended by replacing the word : “felony,” in the first line thereof, by the words : “offences enumerated in article 540 of the Criminal Code, 1892.” R. S., 2593, amended.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
