

CAP. LXI.

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Ste. Cunégonde
of Montreal.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

WHEREAS the school municipality of the city of Ste. Cunégonde of Montreal was authorized by the act 56 Victoria, chapter 53, sections 29, 30 and 31, to borrow an amount of fifty thousand dollars, but whereas the said act has remained inoperative in consequence of the wording of the last paragraph of section 31 of the said act ;

And whereas the said school municipality of the city of Ste. Cunégonde of Montreal has, by petition, represented that it is expedient to correct such wording so as to make the law effective ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Section 31 of the act 56 Victoria, chapter 53, is replaced by the following : 56 V., c. 53, s. 31, replaced.

“**31.** The said school municipality is, further, hereby authorized to acquire real estate within its limits, to construct thereon and enlarge one or more educational establishments, and to establish any school which the school commissioners of the said municipality may deem proper, and to pay the sum aforesaid, and, for that purpose, to levy a sum, not exceeding fifty thousand dollars, at a rate of interest not exceeding five per cent, and to issue bonds or debentures to that amount.” Power of school municipality to acquire real estate, &c.,
And issue bonds therefor.

“The said bonds or debentures shall be issued subject to the provisions of title XIV of the act 53 Victoria, chapter 70, with the exception, however, of articles 496, 497 and 498 of the said chapter, which shall not apply.” Issue of bonds to be subject to provisions of title XIV of 53 V., c. 70.

The school municipality shall further retain the power conferred upon all school corporations in this Province by articles 2035, 2035*a*, 2035*b*, 2035*c*, of the Revised Statutes, and may effect loans, with the authorization of the Lieutenant-Governor, with or without annuities.” Further powers.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
