

CAP. CII.

An Act to authorize the Bar of the Province of Quebec to admit Follin H. Pickel to the study of law without examination.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

**W**HEREAS Follin H. Pickel, of the village of Sweets-  
burg, hath, by his petition, represented:

That he was admitted to the study of medicine, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four;

That he graduated as a physician and surgeon in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight;

And that since that time he has been in active practice as a physician and surgeon in the Province of Quebec;

Whereas he hath prayed that the Bar of the Province of Quebec be authorized to admit him to the study of law without the formality of a preliminary examination; and

Whereas the Councils of the Bar for the sections of Montreal and Bedford approve of the petitioner's application, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts follows:

**1.** The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Follin H. Pickel to the study of law without any preliminary examination.

*F. H. Pickel may be admitted to study law without examination.*

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CAP. CIII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to admit Elzéar Drolet amongst its members, after examination.

[Assented to 9th January, 1897.]

**W**HEREAS Elzéar Drolet, of Quebec, has, by petition, represented:

That he is a British subject and twenty-one years of age;

That he was admitted to the study of the Notarial profession on the eighteenth of May, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine;

That he has followed a regular course of law at Laval University, Quebec, for three years;

That he has served under a practising notary for four consecutive years;
