

It shall be the duty of the college to notify the secretary of the dental association of the time and place at which their examinations in dentistry shall be held, at least one month previous to such examinations.

Notice of examinations to be given to secretary.

“**4061b.** The Dental College of the Province of Quebec, as established by the board of examiners of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, is declared to have a legal existence, and the board of examiners aforesaid shall have, in relation to the universities granting the degree of “doctor of dental surgery” and to which the Dental College of the Province of Quebec is affiliated, all the rights and privileges mentioned in section 2 of the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 32.”

CAP. XXXI.

An Act to amend the law respecting town corporations.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

I. Article 4525 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the word : “Province,” in the second line, the words : “ or on first hypothec to an amount not exceeding one half of the value of the property mortgaged, as appearing by the municipal valuation roll ; provided that provision be made for the insurance of the property so mortgaged, to be taken in the name of the corporation, and at the expense of the borrower, to an amount of not less than one half of the value of the property so insured.”

CAP. XXXII.

An Act to amend the law concerning exemptions from taxation.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

I. The following section and articles are added after article 4643 of the Revised Statutes :

Arts. added after R. S., 4643.

“SECTION VI*a*.

EXEMPTION OF RAILWAY COMPANIES FROM TAXATION .

“**4643a.** It is lawful for any city, town or village municipality to exempt from all taxes, assessments and municipal

from municipal taxation.

To what exemption extends.

imposts whatsoever, for a space of time not exceeding twenty-five years, any railway company having a station within its limits, for the purpose of assisting such company.

Such exemption shall extend to the buildings, track and ground occupied.

“**4643b.** Every by-law, passed in virtue of the preceding article, shall, before coming into force and effect, be approved by the electors of the municipality who are proprietors, in the manner prescribed by the charter of such municipality, or in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Code, and be also subject to the approval of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council when such approval is required under the charter or by law.

“**4643c.** By-laws in virtue of article 4643a may determine the conditions under which the assistance is authorized.”

CAP. XXXIII.

An Act to amend the law respecting Mutual Insurance Companies.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., 5369, amended.

1. Article 5369 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding after the word : “ municipality,” in the ninth line, the words : “ as well as grain, hay, fodder, agricultural implements and household furniture, on or in any of the above mentioned property.

Art. added after R. S., 5370,

2. The following article is added after article 5370 of the said Revised Statutes :

Qualification of directors.

“**5370a.** The directors shall be members of the company and insurers therein, for the time they hold office, to the amount of at least five hundred dollars.”
