

6. The officers of the college shall be patrons, presi-<sup>officers.</sup> dent, two vice-presidents, a bursar and a registrar, and not less than two auditors, and such other persons as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the by-laws.

7. The government of the college and the management<sup>Council.</sup> of its property shall be vested in a council, of not less than fifteen fellows of the college, to be elected by members of the college in such manner as may be prescribed by the by-laws, and of such *ex-officio* members as may, from time to time, be prescribed by the by-laws.

Ten councillors shall be resident in the district of Mont-<sup>Residence of</sup> real, and five shall be resident without the district of<sup>councillors.</sup> Montreal, but within the limits of Canada.

8. The council shall have power, from time to time, to<sup>Power to</sup> make by-laws for the due and proper management of the<sup>make, &c.,</sup> college and its branches, and to revoke, alter or amend<sup>by-laws.</sup> any of the by-laws so made.

9. No member of the College shall be liable for more<sup>Limit of liabi-</sup> than the amount of his subscription.<sup>lity of mem-</sup>

## CAP. LXXVIII.

An Act to amend the act respecting the Compton Model Farm.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

**W**HEREAS the trustees of the corporation of the Compton<sup>Preamble.</sup> Model Farm, the Honorable John McIntosh, sheriff of the district of St. Francis; Herbert D. Smith and Joseph A. Dufort, both farmers, of the township of Compton, have, by their petition, represented :

That the handing over of the entire management of the Compton Model Farm to the Government of this Province, through trustees by it appointed, would be of a nature to assure the maintenance and progress of that institution ;

That the municipality of the village of Compton has, by resolution, consented to abandon its right to appoint two of the trustees who compose the board of management of the said corporation ;

That it is in the interest of the corporation that it be authorized to acquire the immoveables necessary for the purposes of its institution, and to make arrangements with the Government for the maintenance of the school and for other purposes ;

Whereas the petitioners have prayed that the powers necessary for the above purposes be conferred upon the corporation, and it is expedient to grant their prayer ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Section 2 of the act 58 Victoria, chapter 78, is replaced by the following :

**"2.** The corporation may :

**1.** Acquire, accept and receive, by any title, all moveable and immoveable property, and may sell or otherwise dispose of the same, and exercise all the powers necessary for its purposes.

**2.** Make all necessary arrangements with the Government for the maintenance of the said Model Farm, or for the transfer to it of all of its property, moveable and immoveable, and of the rights conferred upon it by its act of incorporation."

**2.** Section 3 of the said act is replaced by the following :

**"3.** The board of management of the said corporation shall consist of seven trustees appointed by the Government, four of whom shall form a quorum.

The present trustees shall remain in office until they resign or are replaced by the Government."

**3.** Section 9 of the said act is replaced by the following :

**"9.** The acquisition of the said farm and buildings, described in section 1 of this act, by the municipality of the village of Compton, is hereby ratified and confirmed.

The said municipality is authorized to sell the said farm and buildings to the corporation hereby incorporated."

**4.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

An Act to incorporate *L'Ecole de médecine comparée et de science vétérinaire de Montréal*, and to repeal the acts incorporating The Montreal School of Veterinary Surgery, and The French Veterinary School of Montreal.
