

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Côme Louis Adolphe Morisset to undergo the examination required by law for admission to the practice of the notarial profession, to grant him a diploma of admission to the practice of the notarial profession, and to admit him amongst its members and to all the rights and privileges appertaining thereto.

#### CAP. XCIV.

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Joseph Abel Fortin, doctor of medicine of Laval University, amongst its members.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

WHEREAS Joseph Abel Fortin, of the parish of St. Hubert, doctor of medicine, has, by his petition, represented :

Preamble.

That he has followed a course of classical studies, that he presented himself at the examination for admission to study medicine in 1889, and was then admitted in all branches, except history and geometry ;

That he then followed a complete medical course at Laval University, that he attended the hospitals during the necessary time, that he has certificates to that effect, that he has all his diplomas from Laval University, at Montreal, and was admitted a doctor of medicine in 1892 ;

That, from that time, he practised medicine in the United States, now desires to practise medicine in this province and to be admitted amongst the physicians and surgeons of the province having a right to practise therein, and that, in order so to do, he requires to have a license from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec ;

That he cannot obtain such license without special authorization, inasmuch as his certificate of admission to study medicine does not cover history and geometry ; but that time, study and experience have supplemented what may have been deficient in his education in 1889 ;

That he is married and requires to continue the practice of his profession immediately, in order to support himself and his family ;

That the Council of the said College does not oppose his petition, and that it is expedient to grant the same ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

College authorized to grant license to J. A. Fortin to practise as physician.

Proviso.

Coming into force.

**1.** The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to grant unto Joseph Abel Fortin, doctor in medicine of Laval University, residing in the parish of St. Hubert, the necessary license to practise Medicine, Surgery and Obstetrics in this Province, and the said Joseph Abel Fortin shall then be considered as a member of the said college, after he has, however, passed the final examination before the said college.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

### C A P . X C V .

An Act to declare Louis George Lecomte a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 21st December, 1895.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Louis George Lecomte, physician and surgeon, of Jewett city, in Connecticut, one of the United States of America, has, by his petition, represented :

That he has obtained his diploma as physician and surgeon from the Victoria School of Medicine and Surgery, in Montreal, after having duly attended the regular courses of the said school ;

That he commenced to attend the course of lectures of that school before obtaining his diploma of admission to study medicine ;

That he is qualified to practise medicine and surgery ; that he cannot now obtain a license to practise medicine and surgery in the Province of Quebec without the special authorization of the Legislature ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act declaring him to be, for the future, a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, and authorizing the said college to grant him the necessary license for the practice of his profession ;

And whereas the said College does not object to the granting of such authorization ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :
