

CAP. VI.

An Act to amend the act 54 Victoria, chapter 88, respecting taxes upon subsidies to railways.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

54 V., c. 88, s. 11, replaced.

1. Section 11 of the act 54 Victoria, chapter 88, is replaced by the following :

Tax on subsidies to railways.

“ 11. The sum of one-half of one per cent on the total amount of subsidy which has been paid, or which shall hereafter be paid, by the Province of Quebec, to aid in the construction of any railway, shall be levied annually on such railway and be payable to the Government by the company, corporation or persons owning or operating such railway, in two equal half-yearly payments, on the first day of July and the first day of January in each year.”

Declaratory.

2. This act shall not be interpreted as declaring that the law was previously different from that herein expressed.

Coming into force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CAP. VII.

An Act respecting the contract between the Government and *Les Frères de la Charité de St. Vincent de Paul.*

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Minimum number of children to be sent under certain contract.

1. The contract respecting the care, supervision and payment of the expenses for the custody and maintenance of juvenile offenders confined in the Montreal Reformatory School, as also the direction and management of the said school, passed on the thirty-first of August, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, between the Government and *Les Frères de la Charité de Saint Vincent de Paul de Montréal*, and ratified by the act 56 Victoria, chapter 8, is modified so that the minimum number of children, at one hundred and thirty dollars each, upon which the said *Frères* may depend, is fixed at two hundred and thirty.
