

## CAP. IX.

An Act respecting the commission appointed to study the question of the cultivation of the sugar-beet.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS a resolution of the Legislative Assembly was passed on the 26th December, 1890, authorizing the appointment of a commission to examine the question of the cultivation of the sugar-beet, obtain all useful information on the matter, visit the places where beet-roots are grown, study the nature of the soil where the plant is most successfully cultivated, and finally make a report of its labors to be submitted to the Legislature, and declaring that the expenses thereof should be paid out of the consolidated revenue fund ;

Whereas, on the 12th of March, 1891, an Order in Council was approved naming N. Bernatchez, member of the Legislative Assembly, and other persons, a commission for such purpose, and such commission made a report ; and whereas the sum of four hundred dollars is to be paid to the said N. Bernatchez for his services upon the said commission, and it is expedient to relieve him from any penalty that he may incur by receiving the said sum ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Payment to N. Bernatchez of certain sum authorized.

**1.** The sum of four hundred dollars shall be paid to the said N. Bernatchez for his services as member of the commission named on the 12th March, 1891, to study the cultivation of the sugar beet.

Not to incur any penalties therefor.

**2.** The said N. Bernatchez shall not, by reason of his acceptance of any remuneration for his services as such commissioner, vacate or forfeit his seat as a member of the Legislative Assembly, or incur any of the penalties imposed by law.

Coming into force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
