Coming into force.

## CAP. XXIX.

An Act respecting the establishment of Commissioners' Courts for the summary trial of small causes.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., 2408, amended.

1. Article 2408 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting the words : "and of at least fifty proprietors of lands or tenements in any", after the word "town," in the second line thereof.

## CAP. XXX.

An Act to amend the law respecting justices of the peace.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Art. added after R. S., 2547.

1. The following article is added after article 2547 of the Revised Statutes :

When oaths to be taken.

"2547a. Such oath, together with the oaths of allegiance and of office, shall be taken by such justice of the peace within six months after his appointment, in default whereof his appointment shall be considered as cancelled."

When oaths to be taken by justices of the peace now appointed.

2. Every justice of the peace, who has not taken the required oaths, shall be bound to do so within six months after the coming into force of this act, and, in default thereof, his appointment shall be considered as cancelled.

Coming into force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
