

CAP. LXI.

An Act respecting the act 57 Victoria, chapter 69.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Sections 1 and 2 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 69, are repealed.

57 V., c. 62,
ss. 11 and 13,
replaced.

2. Sections 11 and 13 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 62, as amended by the said act 57 Victoria, chapter 69, are replaced by the following :

First election
of council.

“**11.** The first general election of the town council shall be held in the month of February, eighteen hundred and ninety-five, as follows : the nomination on the first Monday of the month, and the voting, if any, on the second Monday of the said month.

If such day be a non-judicial day, the election shall be held on the first judicial day following.”

Retiring of
councillors.

“**13.** During the two years following the second Monday of the month of January, eighteen hundred and ninety-five, three councillors shall go out of office at each of the general elections of these two years, and lots shall be drawn, in the manner determined by the council, to decide what councillors shall so go out of office at the two general elections following the said day ; in the third year, the two other remaining councillors shall go out of office.”

First election
in town of
Côte St. Paul.

3. Section 3 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 69, and section 18 of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 64, amended by that act, are repealed, and the election of the council of the town of Côte St. Paul, which was held on the eighth and ninth of January, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, is declared valid and to have been the first general election of the council of the said town.

Coming into
force.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
