

Proviso.

This provision does not extend to amounts due by the corporation to its members under any contract, bargain or undertaking whatsoever.

Effect of receipt of aid.

12. The fact of the widow, orphans or heirs of a deceased member receiving such aid does not constitute an acceptance of such member's succession.

Approval of by-laws, &c.

13. Every amendment to any regulation, every new regulation or repeal of a regulation, not permitted or authorized by this act, shall be approved by two-thirds of the members present, at a general meeting duly convened, and also be approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Return to Lieutenant-Governor.

14. The corporation shall be bound to make an annual return of its operations to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Coming into force.

15. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C A P . L X X X V I I .

An Act to amend the act 39 Victoria, chapter 70, incorporating The Church Home, of Montreal.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS The Church Home, of Montreal, duly incorporated by the act 39 Victoria, chapter 70, has, by its petition, prayed that the said act may be amended so that the said corporation and the management of its affairs shall always be under the direction and governance of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Montreal, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Direction, &c., under whose control.

1. From and after the sanction of this act, the corporation "The Church Home," of Montreal, and the management of its affairs shall always be under the direction and governance of the Lord Bishop of the Diocese of Montreal, who shall always be the president of the said institution.

Approval required for elections, &c.

2. The election of directresses, secretary and treasurer, and committee of management, the appointment of the committee of advisers, and the appointment and removal of all subordinate officers and servants of the said corporation, and all other proceedings of the said corporation shall be

subject to the approval and assent of the said president, who shall have power to veto any and all such elections, appointments, removals and other proceedings. Power of veto.

3. The president shall be free to call meetings of the said corporation, at such time and in such manner as he may see fit. Calling of meetings.

4. All contracts, agreements, deeds of discharge and other deeds requiring to be executed by the corporation, shall be signed by the president, in the name and on behalf of the said corporation, and when so signed shall be binding on the corporation. President to sign all contracts, &c.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

An Act to incorporate The Andrews Home.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

WHEREAS the Right Reverend William Bennett Bond, Lord Bishop of the diocese of Montreal, and Joseph Bell Forsyth, of the city of Quebec, Esquire, Andrew Frederick Gault, of the city of Montreal, merchant, and Francis Wolferstan Thomas, of the said city of Montreal, bank manager, in their qualities of trustees and executors of and under the last will and testament of the late Henry Ogden Andrews, in his lifetime of the said city of Montreal, barrister-at-law and Queen's Counsel, and residing at the time of his death at Leamington, in Warwickshire, England, have, by their petition, prayed that the said Lord Bishop of Montreal and his successors in office, and the said Andrew Frederick Gault and Francis Wolferstan Thomas, together with such other persons as may be nominated and chosen by the Synod of the diocese of Montreal, in the manner hereinafter provided, be incorporated, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining, in or about the city of Montreal, in the said diocese, a charitable church institution, to be called and known as The Andrews Home, under the direction and governance of the Lord Bishop of Montreal, to be used as an asylum or home for emigrants, strangers, and other persons belonging to the Church of England, or for any charitable purpose in connection with the said Church of England, in the said diocese, or necessary for the furtherance of the objects and purposes of the Synod of the diocese of Montreal in its charitable work, with power to hold prop- Preamble.
