

CAP. C V I.

An act to declare Jean Baptiste Wilfrid Ivon a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Jean Baptiste Wilfrid Ivon, physician and surgeon, heretofore of the city of St. Hyacinthe, and now practising medicine at Fitchburg, in the State of Massachusetts, one of the United States of America, has, by his petition, represented :

That he has obtained his diploma as physician and surgeon from the School of Medicine and Surgery of Laval University at Montreal, after having duly attended the regular course of lectures at the said school ;

That he began to attend the lectures at the said school before obtaining his certificate of admission to the study of medicine ;

That he is qualified to practise medicine ;

That he cannot now obtain his licence to practise medicine and surgery in the Province of Quebec without special authority from the Legislature ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act to declare him, hereafter, a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, and to authorize the said college to grant him the licence required to practise his profession ;

Whereas the College of Physicians and Surgeons of this Province do not object to the granting of such authority ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

I. Jean Baptiste Wilfrid Ivon, physician and surgeon, heretofore of the city of St. Hyacinthe and now practising medicine at Fitchburg, in the State of Massachusetts, one of the United States of America, is hereby declared to be a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, which is authorized to grant him a licence to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this Province from the day of the sanction of this act ; provided he shall pass an examination on practical medicine before the Provincial Medical Board.
