

CAP. CVII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to reduce the term of indenture of study of Robert Bennett Hutcheson to one year, and to admit him as a notary and to practise as such.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

WHEREAS Robert Bennett Hutcheson, of the city of Preamble.
Montreal, notarial student, hath, by his petition, represented :

That he was duly admitted to the Bar of this Province, as an attorney and advocate, after having obtained his degree of Bachelor of Civil Law from McGill University, and practised as such attorney and advocate until the seventh day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-four, when he was duly admitted to the study of the notarial profession in this Province, after examination, as required by law, and thereupon was duly indentured with a practising notary, and has since continuously studied such profession ;

That, if he be compelled to follow a clerkship or serve under indenture as such notarial student for the full term of three years, as prescribed by law, very serious loss of time will be unnecessarily entailed upon him, in view of the knowledge and experience attained by him during his study and practice of the legal profession ;

Whereas he hath prayed for an act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to reduce the term of his indenture of study to one year, and to admit him as a notary, and to practise as such after examination ;

Whereas the said Board of Notaries consents to such an act, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petitioner ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to reduce the term of indenture of study of Robert Bennett Hutcheson to one year, and to admit him as a notary, and to practise as such, so soon as he shall have passed the examination required by the law respecting the notarial profession of this Province, and by complying with the prescribed conditions in reference to the same.

Term of study may be reduced and R. B. Hutcheson received as notary.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
