

CAP. CVIII.

An Act to authorize the Board of Examiners of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec to admit Thomas Coleman as a Surgeon Dentist and a member of the said association and to practise as such.

[Assented to 12th January, 1895.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Thomas Coleman, of the city of Montreal, Doctor of Dental Surgery, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is a native born Canadian and subject of Her Majesty;

That he has obtained the degree of Licentiate of Dental Surgery from the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario;

That he has taken a course of dental surgery in and obtained the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery from the University of Michigan;

That, by virtue of the degrees now held by him, and upon registration thereof in the different Provinces and States, he is qualified to practise the profession of dental surgery throughout Canada and the United States of America, excepting only in the Province of Quebec;

That he has passed the Matriculation Examination of the Board of Examiners of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, as required by law, and has obtained the necessary certificate thereof;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Board of Examiners of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to admit Thomas Coleman as a surgeon dentist and member of the said association, with permission to practise the profession of Dental Surgery in the said Province of Quebec, without indenture, after he shall have passed the final examination of the said Board.
