

## CAP. XVIII.

An Act to amend the law relating to agriculture, respecting farmers' clubs.

[Assented to 8th January, 1894.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S., art. 1675c, amended.

1. Article 1675c of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 56 Victoria, chapter 20, section 10, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs :

Amount of subscriptions to determine grant.

"In cases of higher subscriptions, no sum over two dollars per member shall be taken into account in determining the grant made in virtue of article 1675*ii*.

Seed, &c., to be given subscribers of sums over two dollars.

If more than two dollars are paid by any member, the board of management is authorized to give him seed, fertilizers or any other thing calculated to aid in his farming operations, to an amount equal to the additional sum paid by him."

2. Schedule F of the act 56 Victoria, chapter 20, is replaced by the following :

FORM OF AFFIDAVIT REQUIRED BY ARTICLE 1675*ii*.

FARMERS' CLUB OF

LIST AND CERTIFICATE OF SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR THE YEAR

I, the undersigned, president (vice-president or secretary-treasurer) of the Farmers' Club of  
declare on oath that (*here state the names, occupations and post office addresses of all the members of the club, with the sums paid by each opposite to their respective names*), members of the said club, have paid their subscriptions for the current year ; that the said sum consists in current coin and bank-notes current in this Province and not in promissory notes or other securities ; that out of the said sum the sum of

has been expended in discharge of claims against the club, and that there is now on hand the sum of  
dollars, the product of the said subscriptions, disposable according to law.

I further declare that the secretary-treasurer of this club has given a bond to the amount of four hundred

dollars subscribed by (*names, occupation, residence*), who are fully solvent to the said amount, a copy of which bond is hereunto annexed.

An Act to amend the law relating to agriculture and colonization, respecting Farmers' Clubs' Co-operative Societies.

[Assented to 8th January, 1894.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1675*ii* of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by R. S., art. 1675*ii*, amended. the act 56 Victoria, chapter 20, section 10, is amended by adding thereto the following clause :

"Every member of a club is obliged to receive the Members obliged to receive *Journal of Agriculture*, the subscription thereto being deducted from the provincial grant paid to clubs." *Journal of Agriculture.*

2. The following section is added after article 1675*qq* of the said Statutes : Art. added after R. S., art. 1675*qq*.

SECTION *vb*.

FARMERS' CLUBS' CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES.

1675*rr*. The farmers' clubs of any county or territorial division for the establishment of agricultural societies may, Co-operative society how formed. together, form a co-operative society by passing, either collectively or in each club, resolutions to that effect, which they send to the Commissioner of Agriculture.

If the Commissioner approves their organization into a co-operative society, he gives notice thereof in the *Quebec* Name and powers.
