An Act concerning the application of article 4753 of the Revised Statutes.

[Assented to 8th January, 1894.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 4753 of the Revised Statutes shall not apply to R. S., art. any bill presented to either House or to the Lieutenant-Governor for his sanction during the third session of the eighth Legislature. ^{4753, not to apply to bills of this session.}

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into force.}

An Act to amend the law respecting masters and servants.

[Assented to 8th January, 1894.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 5622 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding the following paragraph thereto : ^{R. S., art. 5622, amended.}

“ 2. In the cities of Quebec and Montreal, and in cities, towns and villages which have passed or may pass such by-laws, the penalty incurred by a master or by an apprentice, domestic, servant, journeyman or laborer for any infringement of the laws and by-laws governing the relations between masters and servants, is a fine not exceeding twenty dollars, any special law or all by-laws to the contrary notwithstanding, and, in default of the payment thereof, an imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.” ^{Penalty incurred by master, &c., for infringement of law.}
