

CAP. CVI.

An Act to authorize Didier Garneau, student of dentistry, to practise in the Province of Quebec, by shortening the period of his term of study and indenture, owing to his age and experience.

[Assented to 8th January, 1894.]

WHEREAS Didier Garneau, of the city of Montreal, has, Preamble
by his petition, represented that, for the greater part of the last nine years, he has studied and practised dental surgery; having passed the matriculation examination required before entering upon the study of dentistry; having entered upon the study, he was indentured, and made the study required by the Dental Association, during the first half of his indentures, and obtained from the School of Medicine and Surgery of Montreal the certificate of study required by the law respecting dentists;

Whereas the said Didier Garneau is represented and proved to possess the required professional knowledge and skill as such dentist;

And whereas the said Didier Garneau has proved that his knowledge of the mechanical work of the profession, in the last two years of indenture, is sufficient, and that he is advanced in age and the sole support of his wife and family, and it is expedient to grant his said petition;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The said Didier Garneau shall be entitled to practise the profession of dentist in this Province, after having passed the examination required by law for admission to practise the said profession upon the mechanical and operative part of dental surgery and by paying the fees required by the by-laws for a dentist's diploma. 2. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized, through its proper officers, to grant the said Didier Garneau a certificate as a licensed dental surgeon of this Province, admitting him as a member of the said Dental Association, and to all the rights and privileges enjoyed by the members thereof, immediately after the examination mentioned in the preceding section. 3. The present act shall not affect pending cases and shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Pending cases
