Quebec, 26th January, 1894.

The Lieutenant-Governor in Council.

Whereas, by an Order in Council, No. 478, of the ninth of September, 1892, the fee for incorporating a Fish and Game Club, in the case of persons domiciled in a county of this Province, was fixed at twenty-five dollars;

Whereas, by error, the said Order in Council was reproduced in the Statutes of this Province for 1893, as fixing the fee at twenty dollars;

Therefore, to remedy this error, it is ordered that the aforesaid fee be again fixed at twenty-five dollars, and that the Order in Council No. 478, of the 9th of September, 1892, be confirmed.
