

C A P. X I.

An Act to amend article 36 of the Revised Statutes, respecting holidays.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., art 36,
§ 23, amended.

Holidays

Coming into
force.

1. Clause *c* of paragraph 23 of article 36 of the Revised Statutes is replaced by the following:

“*c.* The festival of the Epiphany, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter Monday, the Ascension, All Saints’ Day, Conception and Christmas Day.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C A P. X I I.

An Act to amend article 630 of the Revised Statutes, respecting the security of public officers.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

630, § 6,
amended.

Coming into
force.

1. Paragraph 6 of article 630 of the Revised Statutes is amended by replacing the word: “eight,” in the fifth line, by the word: “five.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C A P. X I I I.

An Act to amend the law respecting the pensioning of public officers.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S., art. 676
to 691 not to
apply to cer-
tain public
officers.

Coming into
force.

1. Section second of chapter fourth of title third of the Revised Statutes, comprising articles 676 to 691 inclusive, shall not apply to any permanent member of the civil service appointed after the first day of January, eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
