Coming into force.

7 This act shall come into force on the first day of July next after its sanction.

CAP. XXXVIII.

An Act to amend article 17 of the Civil Code, respecting holidays.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

C. C., art. 17, and R. S., art. 5775, amended.

1. Clause 3 of paragraph 14 of the schedule to article 17 of the Civil Code of Lower Canada, as it is contained in article 5775 of the Revised Statutes, is replaced by the following :

Holidays enumerated.

“ 3. The festival of the Epiphany, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter Monday, the Ascension, All Saints' Day, Conception and Christmas Day.”

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
