

CAP. XL.

An Act to amend article 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure, respecting holidays.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Paragraph 3 of article 2 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as it is contained in article 5854 of the Revised Statutes, is replaced by the following :

“ 3. The festival of the Epiphany, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter Monday, the Ascension, All Saints' Day, Conception and Christmas Day.”

Coming into

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CAP. XLI.

An Act to amend the law respecting proofs taken by stenography.

[Assented to 27th February, 1893.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS, to obviate the delays, expense of and inconvenience resulting from the actual system of taking evidence, it is urgent that the method of taking proofs by stenography followed in the districts of Quebec, Montreal, Three Rivers, Saint Francis, Arthabaska, Bedford, Rimouski, Richelieu, St. Hyacinthe, Beauharnois, Iberville, Ottawa, Kamouraska, Terrebonne and Beauce, be applied to the district of Saguenay ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The first paragraph of article 320a of the Code of Civil Procedure, as added by article 5888 of the Revised Statutes, and amended by the acts 54 Victoria, chapter 46, section 1, and 55-56 Victoria, chapter 40, section 1, is further amended by adding thereto after the word : “ Beauce ” the word : “ Saguenay.”
