

CAP. XXII.

An Act to amend the law respecting Agricultural Societies.

[Assented to 24th June, 1892.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The first paragraph of article 1651 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, as amended by the act 52 Victoria, chapter 21, section 1, is replaced by the following :

“ At such meeting, the society may elect a director for each of the parishes or rural municipalities comprised within the limits of the society, and, should the number of such parishes or rural municipalities be less than eight, the meeting may elect directors to complete such number.”

The Council of Agriculture may appoint a director for each Agricultural Society. Such director, upon producing a copy of the resolution of the council establishing his appointment, shall be admitted to exercise all the rights and to carry out all the obligations of the other directors of the society, and shall remain in office during pleasure.

Such director and those elected by the members of each society shall form the board of directors.”

2. Article 1652 of the said Revised Statutes is amended by adding thereto the following words :

“ The Council of Agriculture, however, is alone authorized to fill any vacancy that may arise in the office of a director appointed by it.”

3. Article 1659 of the said Revised Statutes is amended by replacing, in the fourth line, the word “ February ” by the word “ May.”
