

## CAP. XXXII.

An Act to amend the law respecting dentists.

[Assented to 24th June, 1892.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S. Q., art. 4055, and 52 V., c. 40, s. 1, amended. **1.** Paragraph 2 of article 4055 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, as replaced by the act 52 Victoria, chapter 40, section 1, is replaced by the following :

Composition of Board and election of members. **" 2.** The Board is composed of seven members of the association elected at a general meeting held for the purpose, every third year, on the third Wednesday of September ; at which election only one teacher of each faculty of the 'Dental College of the Province of Quebec' shall be eligible for election as a member of the Board."

Art. added after R. S. Q., art. 4055. **2.** The following article is added after article 4055 of the said Revised Statutes, as replaced by the said act :

Establishment of Dental College provided for, &c. **" 4055a.** The Board of Examiners may make arrangements for the establishment of 'The Dental College of the Province of Quebec' in affiliation with the English and French universities of this Province, and for the attendance of students of the 'Dental Association of the Province of Quebec' and others, at such lectures and clinical instruction in such college as shall come within the course or subjects of instruction prescribed by the rules and regulations of the said Board, which course shall be made compulsory upon all candidates who may present themselves for examination to practise dentistry in this Province ; and such further arrangements may be made for obtaining the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery from such universities, as the said universities may determine."

Proviso for students now under indentures. **2.** In the case of registered students now serving their indentureship, they shall be required to conform to the provisions of this article for the balance of their time.

R. S. Q., art. 4058, replaced. **3.** Article 4058 of the said Revised Statutes, as replaced by the said act, is replaced by the following :

Examination for admission to study. **" 4058.** Any person desiring to study dentistry in this Province, must have previously passed the matriculation examination in medicine, prescribed by the universities with which the Board of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is affiliated ; said examination must be passed before the regular university examiners then in office, and a certificate obtained by the candidate of having successful-

ly passed the same, which certificate must be signed by the president of the Board and filed with the secretary of the Dental Board.

2. The candidate must then enter into a notarial agreement with a licensed dentist of this Province actually practising as such in a regularly established office in this Province, and shall deliver into the hands of the secretary of the Board a copy of the said indenture, which indenture the secretary shall then register. Indentures.

From that date only shall the time of study be computed, and the whole office hours of such candidate must be actually engaged in the study and practice of dentistry. Date of time of study, whole time to be devoted to study, &c. Term of study.

3. The term of study under the said indentures, including the necessary courses of lectures and clinics established by the Board, shall be four years. Lectures, &c., to be followed.

4. During that time the student is obliged to follow such courses of lectures and clinics as may be prescribed by the Board."

4. Article 4059 of the said Revised Statutes, as replaced by the said act, is replaced by the following : R. S. Q., art. 4059, replaced.

" 4059. Every person desirous of being examined by the Board touching his qualifications for the practice of dentistry in this Province shall, at least one month before the regular sitting of the Board, pay into the hands of the treasurer the required fee, and enclose and deliver to the secretary the treasurer's receipt for the same, together with evidence satisfactory to the Board of his studentship integrity and good morals. Notice to be given by candidates for practice, fees, &c.

2. If the Board is satisfied by the examination that the person is duly qualified to practise dentistry, and is further satisfied that he is a person of integrity and good morals, it shall, subject to the rules, regulations and by-laws of the said association and Board, grant him a license to practise dentistry in this Province, and the title of ' Licentiate of Dental Surgery.' " License to be given after examination, &c.

5. Article 4060 of the said Revised Statutes, as replaced by the said act, is hereby repealed. R. S. Q., art. 4060, repealed.

6. Article 4065 of the said Revised Statutes as replaced by the said act, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraphs : R. S. Q., art. 4065, amended.

" 7. It shall be unlawful for any licentiate to keep open more than one dental office, unless each additional office be under the direct control and attendance of a registered dental licentiate of this Province actually in practice. Only one office to be kept, unless by licentiate.

" 8. It shall be unlawful for students, or others than dental licentiates of this Province actually in practice, to take charge of an office or act before the public in the capacity No one, other than dental licentiates, to take charge of an office.

Proviso.

of a regular dentist, or for licentiates to represent to the public that such persons are qualified and entitled to so act; provided that this article shall not prevent any duly indentured and registered student of dentistry of this Province from receiving clinical instruction and practice under the supervision of a dental licentiate of this Province."

## CAP. XXXIII.

An Act to amend the law respecting railways in this Province.

[Assented to 24th June, 1892.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

R. S. Q., art. 5148, amended.

1. Article 5148 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec is amended by replacing the words: "three minutes", in the fourth, seventh and eighth lines thereof, by the words "one minute".

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

## CAP. XXXIV.

An Act to amend the act 53 Victoria, chapter 47, respecting the width of roads and streets in cities, towns and villages.

[Assented to 24th June, 1892.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

53 V., c. 47, s. 4, amended.

1. The following words are added to the act 53 Victoria, chapter 47, section 4:

Streets may be less than sixty-six feet wide.

"The city, town or village council may, with the permission of the Lieutenant-Governor in Council obtained on petition to him addressed, in special and exceptional cases, order that the width be less than sixty-six feet.

Not to apply to Montreal.

This section, however, shall not apply to the city of Montreal."
