

## C A P. C X V.

An Act to declare Joseph Frenette, a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 24th June, 1892.]

**W**HEREAS Joseph Frenette, of Saint Etienne de la Malbaie, student of the School of Medicine and Surgery of Montreal, of the faculty of Medicine of the Laval University, at Montreal, did, on the twentieth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two, receive the degree of doctor in medicine at the Laval University; and should have the right to be admitted to practise the medical profession in this Province; Preamble.

Whereas he began to follow the courses of the said school before being regularly admitted to the study of medicine, and that he was admitted to study only on the thirteenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one;

Whereas he cannot now receive his licence without a special authorization from the Legislature; and

Whereas the College of Physicians and Surgeons of this Province does not object to this authorization being given;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Joseph Frenette, of Saint Etienne de la Malbaie, doctor in medicine, is declared to be a member of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, which is authorized to grant him the requisite licence for the practice of medicine and surgery and midwifery in this Province, from the day of the sanction of this act.
