

CAP. CIII.

An Act to declare Joseph Narcisse Létourneau a member of the College of physicians and surgeons of the Province of Quebec.

[Assented to 30th December, 1890.]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Joseph Narcisse Létourneau, doctor in medicine, of the city of Montreal, has the knowledge required to be admitted to the study of the medical profession ;

Whereas he has undergone a complete classical course ;
Whereas he was induced not to present himself for examination to be admitted to the study of medicine, but to go to the United States and live with his family and there practise his profession as doctor ;

Whereas he returned to this country, with his family, when the last attempts were made towards repatriation by the Government ;

Whereas he could not now pass the ordinary examination required to practise his profession without sustaining great damage ; whereas he has obtained the degree of doctor in medicine at the Laval University ;

Whereas it is right, under the circumstances, to declare him a member of the College of physicians and surgeons of the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas this body does not object ;

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

J. N. Létourneau, declared member of College of Physicians, &c.

1. Joseph Narcisse Létourneau, of the city of Montreal, doctor in medicine, is declared to have become a member of the College of physicians and surgeons of the Province of Quebec, which is authorized to grant him the requisite license for the practice of medicine and surgery and obstetrics in this Province, from the day of the sanction of this act.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
