

CAP. XXII.

An Act to amend article 1618 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, respecting the formation of agricultural societies.

[Assented to 2nd April, 1890.]

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1618 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec is amended by inserting the word "Huntingdon" after the word "Pontiac" in the third line thereof. R. S. Q., art. 1618 amended.

2. This act shall come into force upon the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CAP. XXIII.

An Act respecting Agricultural Society No. 5 in the county of Gaspé.

[Assented to 2nd April, 1890.]

WHEREAS for many years there existed in the county of Gaspé, in the registration and municipal division of Ste. Anne des Monts, an agricultural society known as Agricultural Society No. 3 of the county of Gaspé ; Preamble.

Whereas the said society ceased its operations for some years, but has recently been reorganized by certain inhabitants of the parishes of Ste. Anne des Monts and Cap Chat, under the name of the Agricultural Society No. 5 of the county of Gaspé ;

Whereas doubts have been raised as to the interpretation to be given to the provisions of article 1625 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Quebec, as regards the number of societies that the county of Gaspé may retain, subject to article 1618 which permits of its being divided into two separate divisions for agricultural purposes ; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislature of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Agricultural Society Number 5 of the county of Gaspé, reorganized, as stated in the preamble of this act, by the inhabitants of Ste Anne des Monts and Cap Chat, is hereby recognized and confirmed under such number as may hereafter be given to it by the Council of Agriculture, and shall be entitled to all the rights of other agricultural societies.
